
- 1) Staff must be provided with all materials necessary for the needs of the child. All belongings should be properly labeled. ATC is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Water bottles, Sippy cups or "no- spill" cups are permitted if they are labeled. To avoid conflict with other children, the ATC also asks that no outside toys be brought in as well.
- 3) Occasionally children experience feelings of distress when having to ask a new caregiver to go to the restroom. For this reason, we ask that all children take care of this prior to entering the nursery. This is also true for children in diapers.
- 4) All children must be checked in by a parent or guardian at the door by a nursery attendant, parents need to be on ATC premises the entire time the child is participating in the nursery.
- 5) ATC reserves the right to deny or terminate childcare services for any reason including, but not limited to the following: overcrowding, suspected illness, or behavioral issues.
